Obtain License Key – clicking the CPLLC.net link will take you to the webpage to purchase a license key.


License Key – this extension requires a paid license key which can be obtained by clicking the above. For testing purposes, this extension will function 100% for 2 hours. Rebooting will reset the two hours.

IP Address - IP address of the FX Luminaire controller

Show on Home Screem – Checked if you want the extension to display on the home screen.

Show on Room Screen – Checked if you want the extension displayed on the room page.

Actions



Group Off – Turn selected group off. A list of group names will be displayed for selection. Only a single group can be selected.

Group On – Turn selected group on. A list of group names will be displayed for selection. Only a single group can be selected.

Theme Off – Turn selected theme on. A list of theme names will be displayed for selection. Only a single theme can be selected.


Theme On – Turn selected theme off. A list of theme names will be displayed for selection. Only a single theme can be selected.

All Off - Turn all landscaping lights off.

All On – Turn all landscaping lights on.

Set Group Level – Set the group's intensity level to use when the next group is turned on. Crestron Home extension only allow one variable to selected for each Action.

End-User Experience






The left image shows feedback if an invalid IP address is entered into the extension. The right image shows the feedback when the license has expired.

On – turns on all landscape lights.


Off – turns off all landscape lights.

ReSync – retrieves the latest list of groups and themes from the FX Luminaire controller.


GROUPS

The group names are retrieved from the FX Luminaire controller and configured using the mobile app.



Left Arrow – displays the previous group.


Right Arrow – displays the next group.

On – turn group's lights on to 100%.

Off – turn group's light off.

-/+ - increments the light's intensity level between 0 and 100%. Since this involves an HTTP call for each increment, there will be noticeable lag in the light's response.


THEMES

Left Arrow – displays the previous theme.

Right Arrow – displays the next theme.

On – turn theme's lights on.

Off – turn theme's light off.
