





Channel 1 Motor Name – a channel is defined if the channel has a name. Leave blank if the channel is not active.

Channel 2 – 24 Motor Name – as described above.



Add Motor – add the selected channel name.

Delete Motor – delete the selected channel name.

Close – close the selected channel name.

Open – open the selected channel name.

Stop – stop the selected channel name.


Save – save the selected channel name's current position.

Goto – go to the selected channel names' saved position.


Tilt Down – tilt down the selected channel name.

After 2 hours, without the proper license key having been installed, a license expired notice will be displayed.




After the room tile has been clicked the list of defined channels are presented.
